Prize money for this 6 star event is set at 35 000 euro's.

It is a huge sandy basin with a lagoon stretching over 50km's and a North Westerly wind, which is prevalent all year round.

There are natural thermals that accelerate down the peninsular that meet the cold Atlantic, offering a strong constant wind for the riders.

It offers a unique kitesurfing adventure for riders and travelers alike, with your accommodation under canvas and your travels off the beaten track, what better way to experience the KPWT with Dakhla attitude!!

The spot of Dakhla - wind condition :

The regular and hot wind (NNE) from 4 to 7 bft and the sunshine of the South of Morocco offer excellent sailing conditions throughout the year. In front of the club, the wind is enhanced by a venturi effect which runs along the hills.

The spot of Dakhla - water condition :

The temperature stays around $20-28^{\circ}\text{C}$ / $68-82^{\circ}\text{F}$ all year but can drop at night, so take a few warm clothes.

HOW TO GET THERE

By Plane:

There is an airport in Dakhla. Royal Air Maroc guarantees three flights a week from Casablanca to Dakhla (two-way flights Casablanca/Dakhla every Monday, Wednesday and Friday). Flights on the other days of the week are guaranteed by the Regional Airlines, the Moroccan Regional Company.

By Car:

From the north of Morocco, you go southward towards Agadir. Then, you go in the direction of the Great South towards Laayoun, then Dakhla (1200 km from Agadir, 1800 from Casablanca).

By Bus:

The Companie de Transport au Maroc (CTM) guarantees daily roundtrips between Dakhla and Agadir (Euro 70), and between Dakhla and Marrakech (Euro 80).
